Katrina Velle Research Grant Commitment

A multi-year commitment totaling \$104,000 to fund research at The University of Massachusetts Dartmouth. This grant will support research into the basic biology of Naegleria, an important step to aid the discovery of new treatment options.

Moseman Lab Grant

A \$33,000 grant was distributed, the second installment of a 2 year commitment, for the continued research on Aven's Assay. The Lab is making productive progress in developing a clinical diagnostic tool for PAM. The goal is to create a lateral flow assay that can detect Naegleria fowleri antigens for clinical diagnostic purposes.

Aven's case study and recommendations for early diagnosis were presented in the article.

Graduate Student Collaboration
